Your project must identify a specific challenge/problem in an existing short food supply chain (SFSC) and develop an exploitable solution to that challenge/problem. Your aim is to improve the competitiveness of the SFSC in a way that maintains or improves resource efficiency and is climate-friendly, while also leading to the growth of the SFSC towards an intermediate food supply chain. The solution that your team proposes may address an economic, social, organizational or technological challenge in the existing SFSC and should be potentially applicable to other SFSCs. Examples could be anywhere in the value chain including raw materials through processing, packaging, logistics and marketing.

Do you have a great idea?

Form a team of 3-5 students and present your project proposal by 23H59 CEST on 31/03/2023 at [FoodFactory-4-Us Edition 2023](#). Teams from around the world are invited to participate.

Accepted teams will participate in an online, innovative, learner-centric environment based on participatory action-learning to improve knowledge and competences, group cooperation, and teamwork.

Project evaluation is 'real', carried out by food industry and/or food associations who, with academics, evaluate projects.
